



TODAY'S ARTIST

Hailed as a "Celtic guitar god" by Baltimore's *City Paper* and "one of the best folk instrumentalists in the business" by *Sing Out!* magazine, **Robin Bullock** is one of the preeminent acoustic music masters of our time.

He blends the ancient melodies of the Celtic lands, their vigorous American descendants, and the masterworks of the Baroque and Renaissance eras into one powerful musical vision. The 17th-century harp tunes of legendary Irish bard Turlough O'-Carolan, the spirited jigs and reels of rural Ireland, the haunting ballads of the southern Appalachians, and the timeless compositions of Bach all find a musical common ground in Robin's music, where lightning-fast fingerwork one moment is perfectly balanced with tender, quiet intimacy the next.

A performer and recording artist for over 30 years, Robin is accomplished on acoustic guitar, mandolin, cittern, piano, bass guitar, fiddle and banjo. Also an accomplished composer, his credits include soundtracks for films, TV, and documentaries. In addition, Robin is a familiar staff presence at leading acoustic music camps, including the nearby Swannanoa Gathering in Asheville, North Carolina.
